*** REQUIREMENTS***

- Applicants should be a full-time dues paying member for a minimum of four (4) years; or Applicant should be a part-time dues paying member for a minimum of five (5) years.
- Applicant is responsible for securing proof of eligibility for the scholarship, i.e. bill from the school.
- As a condition to reapply for the Joseph Franklin Scholarship, applicant must maintain a minimum of 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA), by providing a current transcript. Scholarship renewal is contingent upon funding availability and cannot be given more than 2 times to an applicant.
- Applicant must supply recommendations and/or references from each of the following: (1) an 1199J member with 10 years of service, (2) a character reference from a teacher, clergy, community leader, etc.; (3) an 1199J union delegate with 5 years of service.
- Applicant must supply a bio and photo
- Applicant must submit an essay of not less than 150 words (**submitted typed in Microsoft Word-Times Roman 12 double spaced**) on the subject of *"What 1199J has Meant to Me and My Family"*.
